such as the width and height of the existing quay. The design proposes to extend the space of the quay by a continuously evolving undulation of the quay wall, thereby providing at its shallowest


This undulating line defines then the movement define a full circle walk from the medieval centre of the design from the neighbouring St. Johann Park to the France border - a metaphor of the
