

Izuran Hotel Resort, Marrakech

The garden of the Izuran Resort in Marrakech is founded on the existing qualities of a site encompassing 15 hectares and approximately 1000 trees.

Atelier Girot defined the master plan as well as the landscape plan for this project. The program includes a hotel, its leisure areas and spa; as well as ten individual villas. Individualized gardens of

quality within a complex distribution system had to be resolved. The central axis traversing the entire site becomes the structural base for the entire project.

Water, its distribution and collection plays a major structural role, using the light slope of the terrain to convey the main circulation paths, in reference to rich cultural use of water in andalusian archi-

itecture and landscape garden design.

To the existing trees, a rich palette of fruit trees will be added. It is a place to awaken the senses, a place to dream and relax.

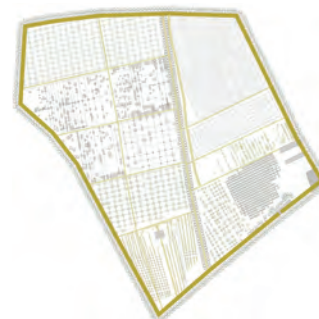
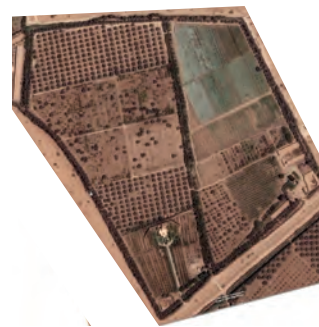

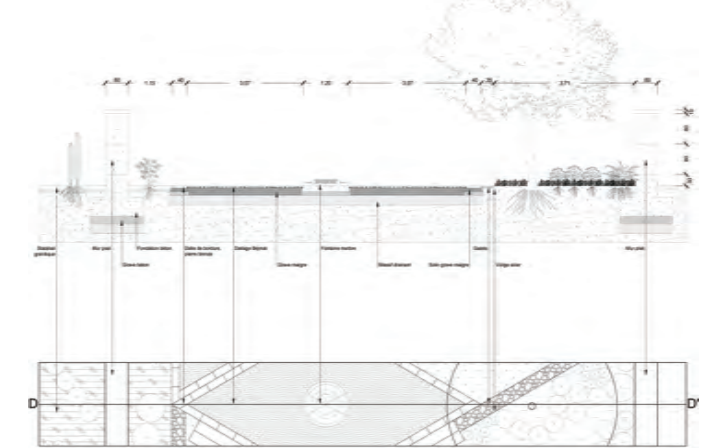


- 1 Master plan hotel & suites
